

Golf Operation Conditions Effective 1st August

- Timesheets are in use for managing all golf prior to 2pm.
- Instructions for the random draw process are listed after clicking the book now option on the club's website.
- Registration for the random draw will open at 6pm 5 days in advance, and bookings will be available from 6:30pm onward.
- Timesheets are set for 4 players per group and a maximum of 2 players can be booked by any one Member onto a time sheet, except for play on Wednesdays, Sundays and Monday Men's Times when a group of 4 can be booked.
- Play will be in 8 minute intervals all day.
- All booking limitations have been removed, so that each Member can play golf according to their playing category
- The first tee time of the day will be 6:45am, except for Mondays (7am) and Wednesdays (8am).
- Scorecards will be available for collection in the Pro Shop. Each player is responsible to record his / her own score on their card. At the completion of the round the player will verbally confirm the scores with the marker and upon confirmation the player will initial the space on the scorecard which is designed for the marker's signature. The computer will not accept the card without signatures and / or initials in both the player's and the marker's space. The player should also record the marker's score to assist in the post round confirmation of their score. This practice will ensure that only the player is handling his or her own card.
- On Mondays 7:00-8:36am & 10:20am-12:45pm will be exclusive Men's times, 8:44-10:12am exclusive Women's times and from 12:55pm onwards Social play.
- On Tuesdays the exclusive Ladies' times will run to 12:30pm, and to 11:00am on Fridays.
- On Wednesdays from 8am-12.45pm, an optional Medley Competition will run in conjunction with Social play.
- Time sheets will now close the day before at 8pm. Any cancellations from a closed time sheet will need to be made by phoning the Pro Shop.
- Members may play only if they have a booking in their own name. Please do not give your booking to
 another person. If you are unable to play, please remove yourself from the time sheet, or contact the Pro
 Shop if the sheet is closed.
- The driving range, chipping green and practice putting green will be open for warm up & practice. Please note that Members who are warming up for their booked round have priority on the driving range.
- Members need to adhere to all social distancing protocols.
